Dear Video Media / Broadcast Educators:

I wish to draw your attention to the 2020 Scholarship and Grant Educational Opportunities offered by our Scholarship/Education Committee of the Michigan Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences (MI-EMMY® Awards).

For High School Classes, we offer a competitive grant, awarded to the High School and its Broadcast/Film CLASS to help purchase broadcasting/film-video/editing equipment. This year, there are five (5) High School Grant Awards for \$1,000. each.

For College Students, we offer six (6) college scholarships: four (4) on the undergraduate level and two (2) on the graduate level. [Eligibility: Undergraduates: Junior (3rd-yr.) and/or Senior (4th-yr) currently enrolled with 60+ credit hours, earned by June 2020, or a Graduate Student pursuing a Masters/Doctorate degree in TV/Film/related areas at an accredited institution.] This year, there are six (6) \$2500. College Scholarships.

There are no application fees. Students do **not** have to be members of MI-NATAS to apply, nor to enter our Student Production Awards. But, for those students who would like to become members, the Student (High School or College) Membership fee is only \$10.00 per year. It is a great way to network with professionals and be kept informed about employment opportunities. Peruse our website.
