On behalf of the **2022 John Schimpf College Scholarship & Dr. Lynne Boyle High School Grant Committee**; we hope this communication finds You (and your families) doing well. This has been an unprecedented two (2) years; especially as it has had an impact on education, including learning modalities, platforms and future financing. It is with an unwavering commitment to encourage and support our future journalists and media students that we announce our 2022 MI-NATAS Scholarship and Grant offerings.

For **High Schools**, we offer a competitive grant, awarded to a High School and its Broadcast/Film **CLASS** to help purchase broadcasting/film-video/editing equipment. This year, there are five (5) High School Grant Awards for \$1,500 each.

For **College Students**, we offer five (5) college scholarships. Undergraduates, who have declared a media major (journalism, video production, broadcasting); ie., holding and enrolled (with 45+ credit hours) at an accredited institution; or a graduate student pursuing a Masters/Doctorate degree in TV/Film/related areas, are eligible to be awarded one of five (5) \$2500 scholarships.

There are no application fees. Students need **not** be members of MI-NATAS, nor entrants in our Student Production Awards to apply... but are encouraged to fully participate in all our industry activities. Memberships (High School or College Student) costs only \$10.00 per year. Membership is a great way to network with professionals and be kept informed about employment opportunities.
